Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or REALife Group.

1. List some of the “Jesus, Take the Wheel” moments of your life. Spend some time reflecting on them. What truths are still with you today that God taught you in those moments of your life? Are there any of these truths to which you need to return? Which ones? Why?
2. What makes it difficult for you to remove yourself from the driver's seat? Read John 10:10 and Matthew 13:44-46. In what ways, if any, do these passages help you slide over to the passenger seat?
3. Romans 12:1-2 offers a great way to get started with living a “Jesus,- Take-the-Wheel” kind of life. What would it look like for you to take some of these steps personally? The word “transformed” in v.2 comes from the same root as the word “metamorphosis”. What does this tell you about the importance of renewing your mind? How would you go about the process of renewing your mind?
4. *Salvation*, in its basic sense, happens at the moment we place our faith in Jesus. However, *transformation* is a life-long process; a step-by-step process. Write down one step that you will take this week which you believe will make the greatest difference in your personal transformation. Who will you look to for help in taking that step? When will you ask for their help?
