Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or REALife Group.

1. Give some examples of people that God has placed in your path that you can help. Why is it so important to capture each of these opportunities and not pass them by?
2. The miracle of the healing draws a crowd. How did Peter handle that situation? (See Acts 3:11-25) What are some insights that you can apply, from what Peter said, to your witnessing opportunities?
3. Notice the number of times that the "name" of Jesus appears in this passage. (See Acts 3:6, 16, Acts 4:7, 10, 12, 17, 18, 30) Read Acts 4:12 and compare that to Jesus' words in John 14:6. How would you answer the complaint that Christianity is too narrow?
4. Have you ever faced embarrassment or persecution from sharing your faith? How has that affected you?
