Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or REALife Group.

1. Read Acts 1:1-10. Now think through the whole book and make a list of all of the amazing things that were accomplished in the 30 years of Acts. What are some of the things that you have seen accomplished at HCBC over the past 23 years? How about in your life?
2. Read the parables about the Kingdom in Matthew 13:44-45 and Mark 4:26-32. What are some of the things we learn about the kingdom from these parables? Why is it important to understand that personal salvation is about being part of God's Kingdom and not just escaping hell?
3. What are some of the things you see in the world that reflect the growing conflict between the kingdom of Satan and the Kingdom of God? (Try to stay away from just talking about political issues.)
4. When the story of your missional activity is told in the kingdom, what would you like that story to say?
