Plain Meaning:

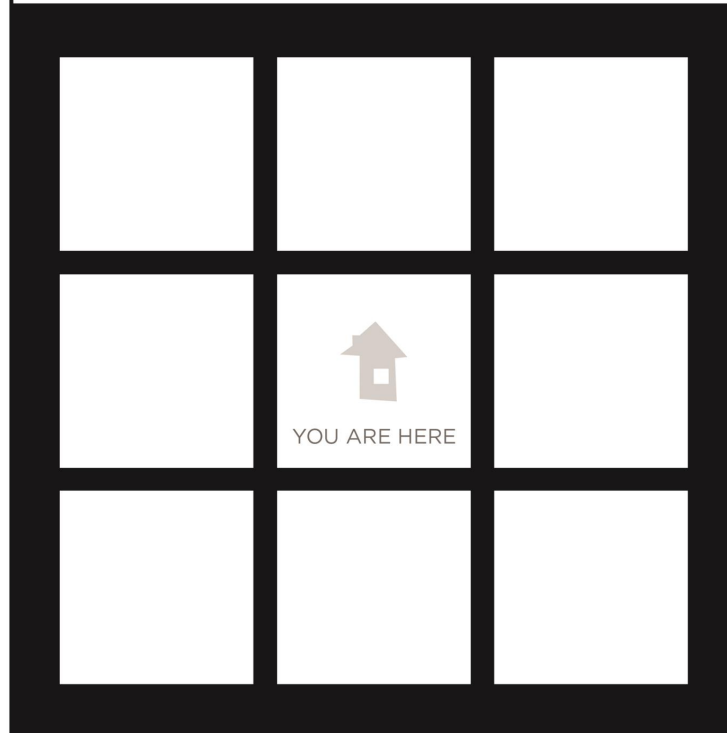
Hebrew = “One who crosses my path”
